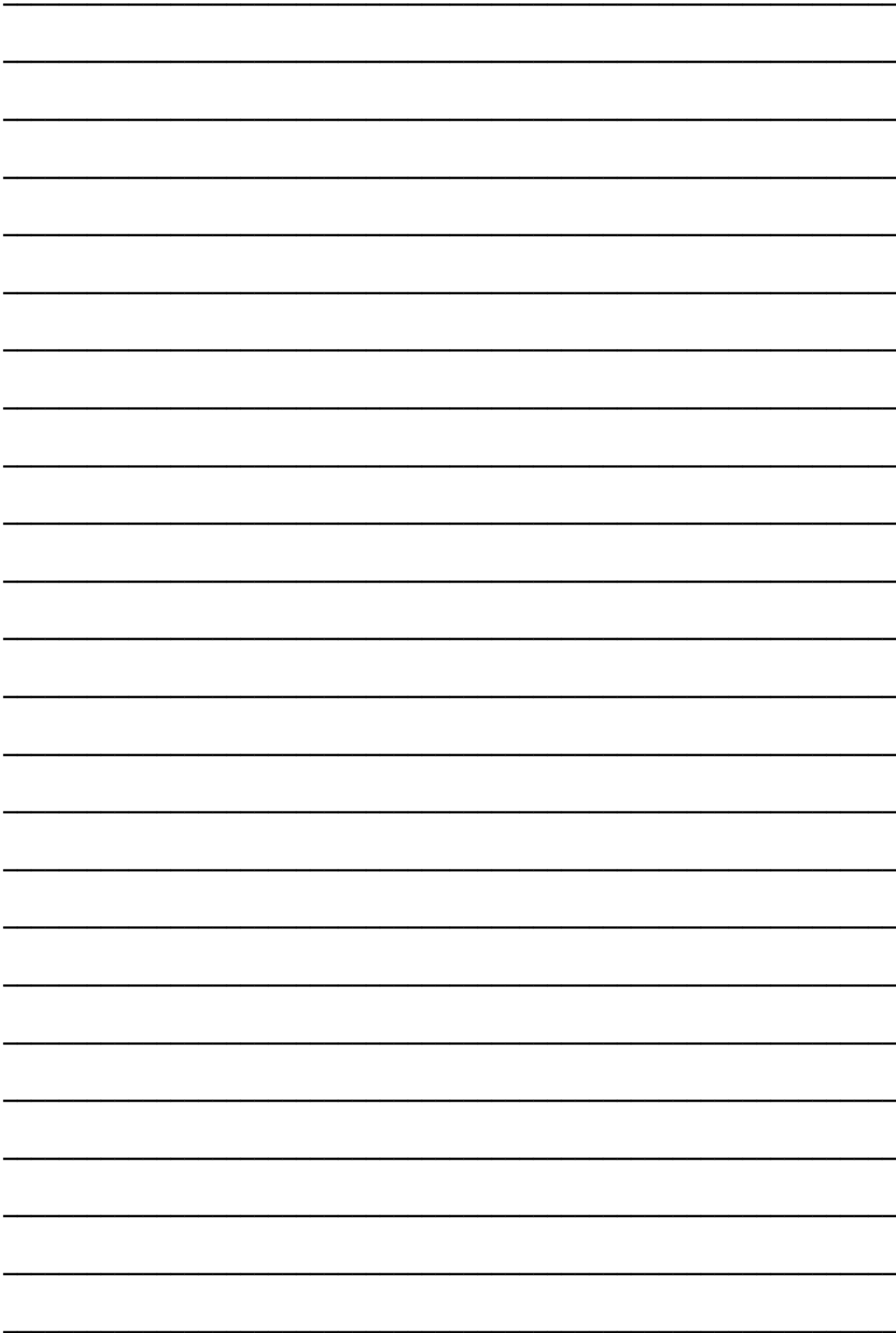
**“...do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.” Romans 12:2**

## Spirit, Soul & Body

**SPIRIT:** God has given us the Spirit as our inner man, our inner being that is 100% righteous, 100% united with Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit forever and ever. We are sanctified, we are set apart, we are holy, we are righteous and live forever united with God. It is all available because of His Grace.

**PHYSICAL BODY:** *“...therefore, we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.” 2 Corinthians 4:16*

**SOUL:** The seat of the mind, will, and emotions. The battle exists in the mind. Satan cannot indwell my spirit, he cannot link himself to my spirit, he cannot come in and mess around with my spirit. But where he is messing with me is in the battleground of the mind. Only the truth delivered to us in a revelatory way by the power of the Holy Spirit can free us in the practical realm to be able to live in such a way and behave in such a way that behaviour is consistent with who we already are in our spirit man.

You are a new creation. God has given you a new heart and a new spirit.

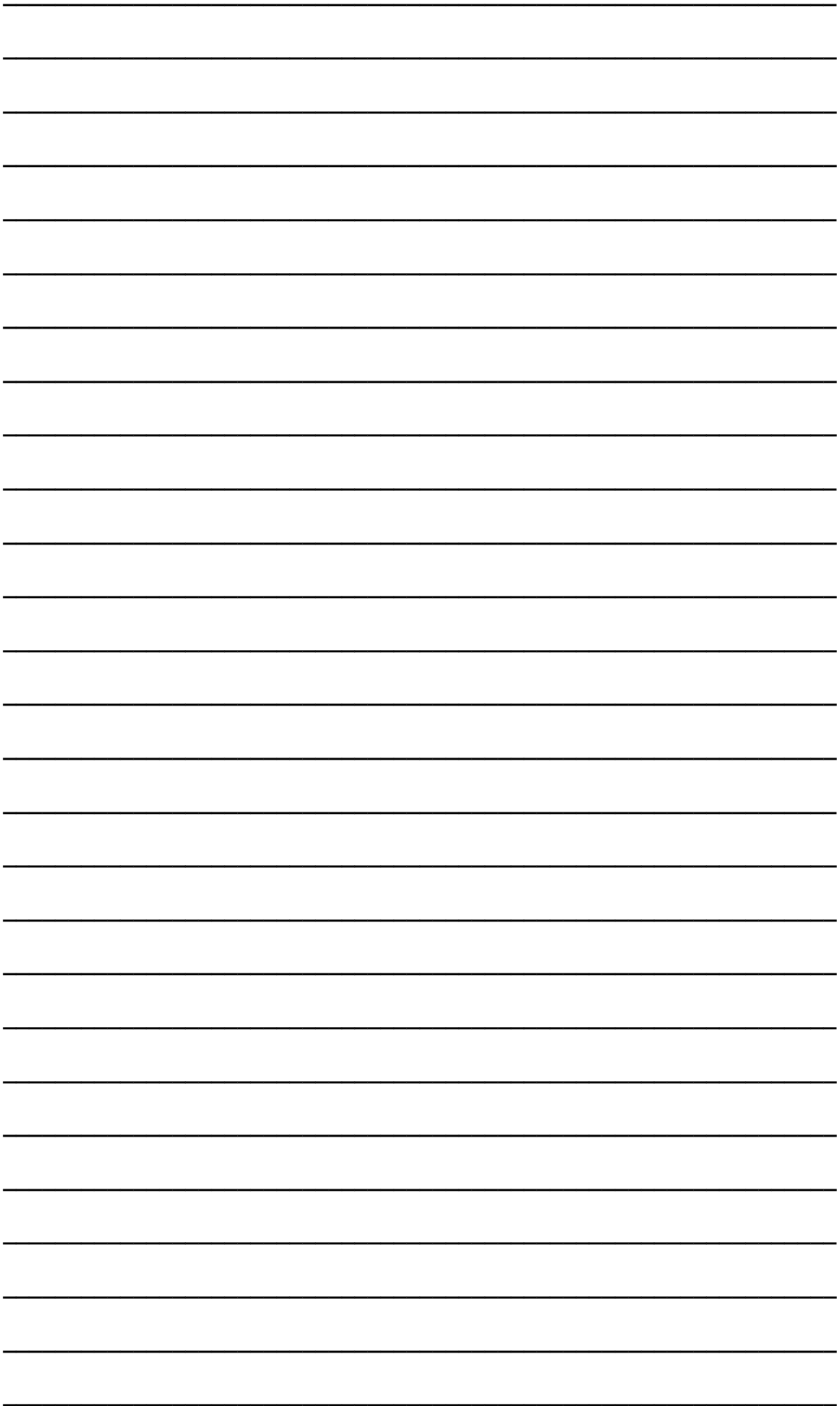

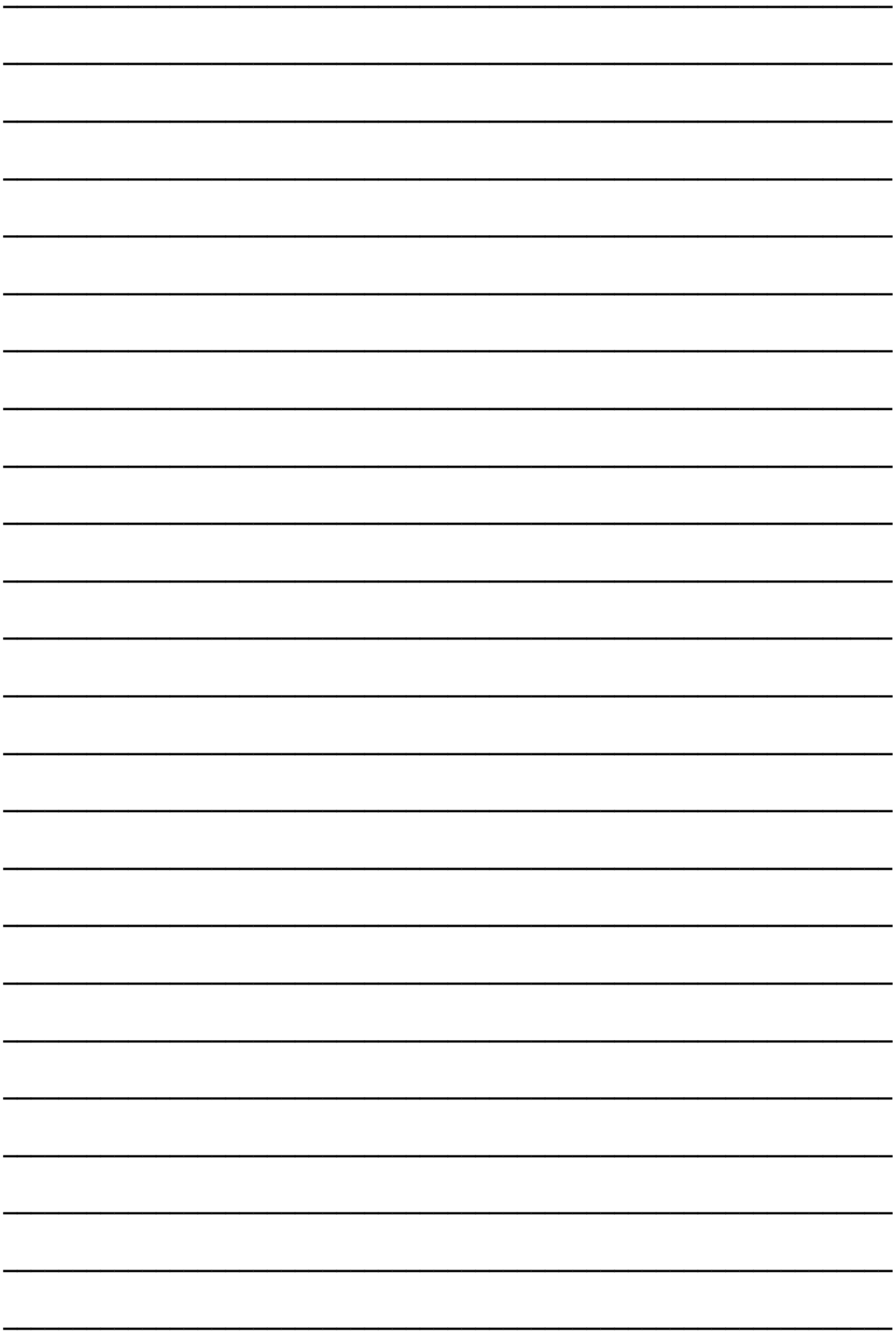
**“For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.” 1 Corinthians 1:18**

**“Now when the people saw what Paul had done, they raised their voices, saying in the Lycaonian language, “The gods have come down to us in the likeness of men!” And Barnabas they called Zeus, and Paul, Hermes, because he was the chief speaker. Then the priest of Zeus, whose temple was in front of their city, brought oxen and garlands to the gates, intending to sacrifice with the multitudes. But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard this, they tore their clothes and ran in among the multitude, crying out and saying, “Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the living God, who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all things that are in them, who in bygone generations allowed all nations to walk in their own ways. Nevertheless, He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did good, gave us rain from heaven and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and gladness.” And with these sayings, they could scarcely restrain the multitudes from sacrificing to them. Then Jews from Antioch and Iconium came there; and having persuaded the multitudes, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead.” Act 14:11-19**



## Grace is Antithetical

Religion started in the Garden of Eden.

**“Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden’? ”And the woman said to the serpent, “We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, ‘You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.’ ” Then the serpent said to the woman, “You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.” So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.” Genesis 3:1-7**

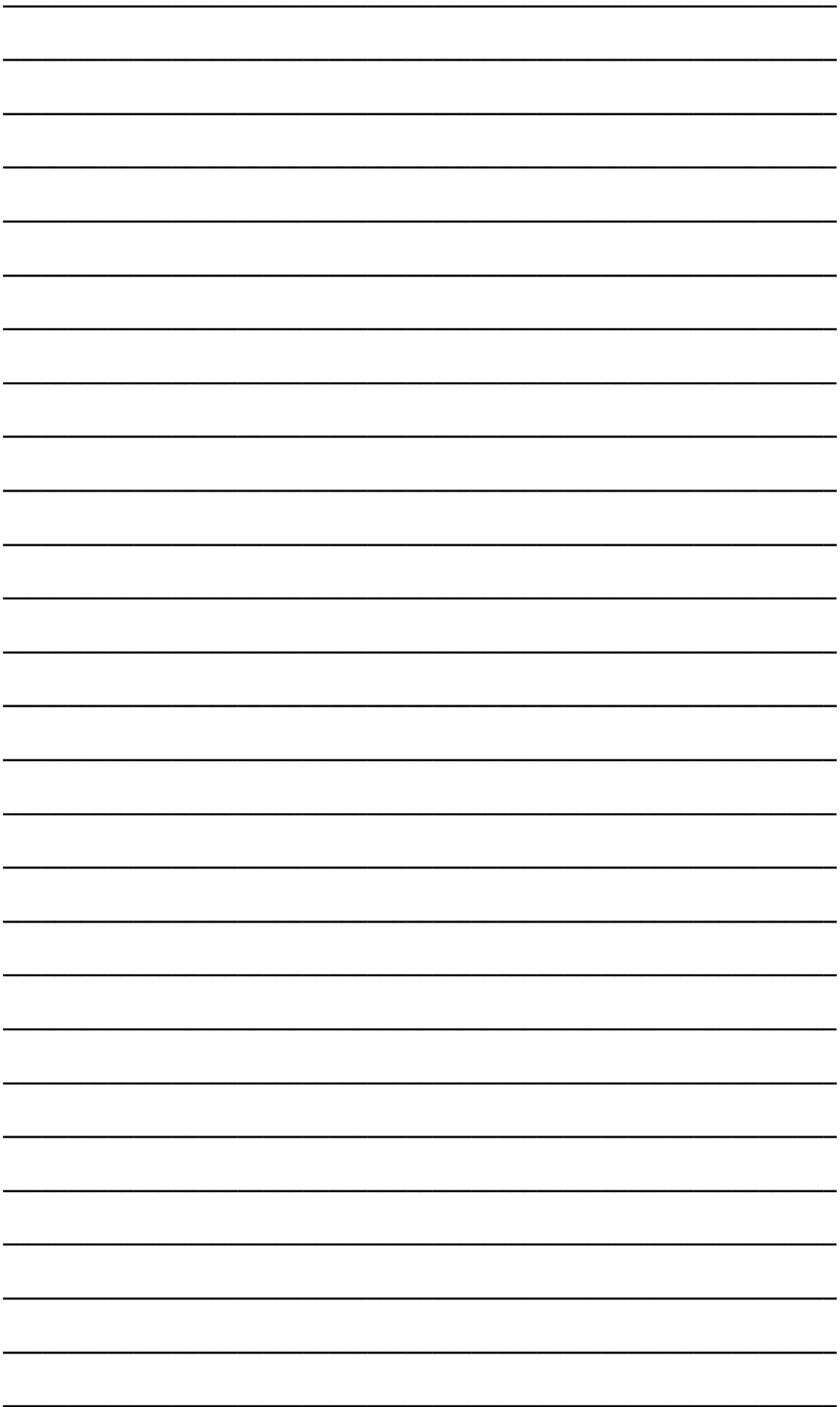

The first sacrifice was in Genesis. Grace is unique from other religions. Grace is offensive to the flesh, to the pharisee within.

Different theological systems.

- \* Armenism: Teaches you can lose your salvation.
- \* Calvinism: You really have no assurance.
- \* Reformed Theology: You are saved as long as you persevere.

The Gospel says you are saved no matter what!



## Grace: A Solution to Sin

Grace is not a license to sin, but the solution to sin.

**“For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.” Romans 6:14**

**“For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age...” Titus 2:11-12**

**Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? Romans 2:4**

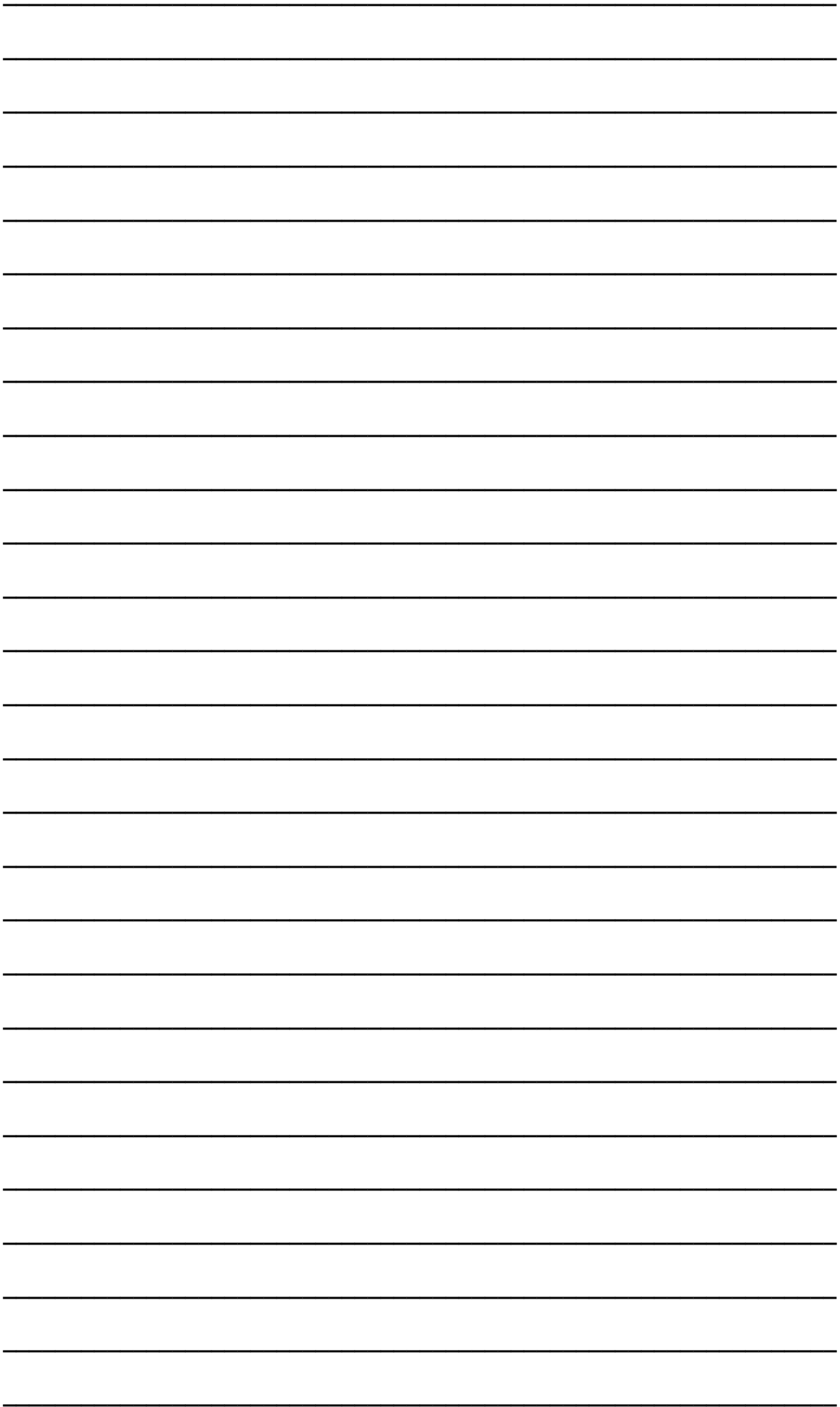

***Lordship Salvation:*** Teaches you can't receive Jesus as the Savior without submitting to Him as Lord. You cannot be saved unless you make a bunch of promises to God about how you are going to change your life.

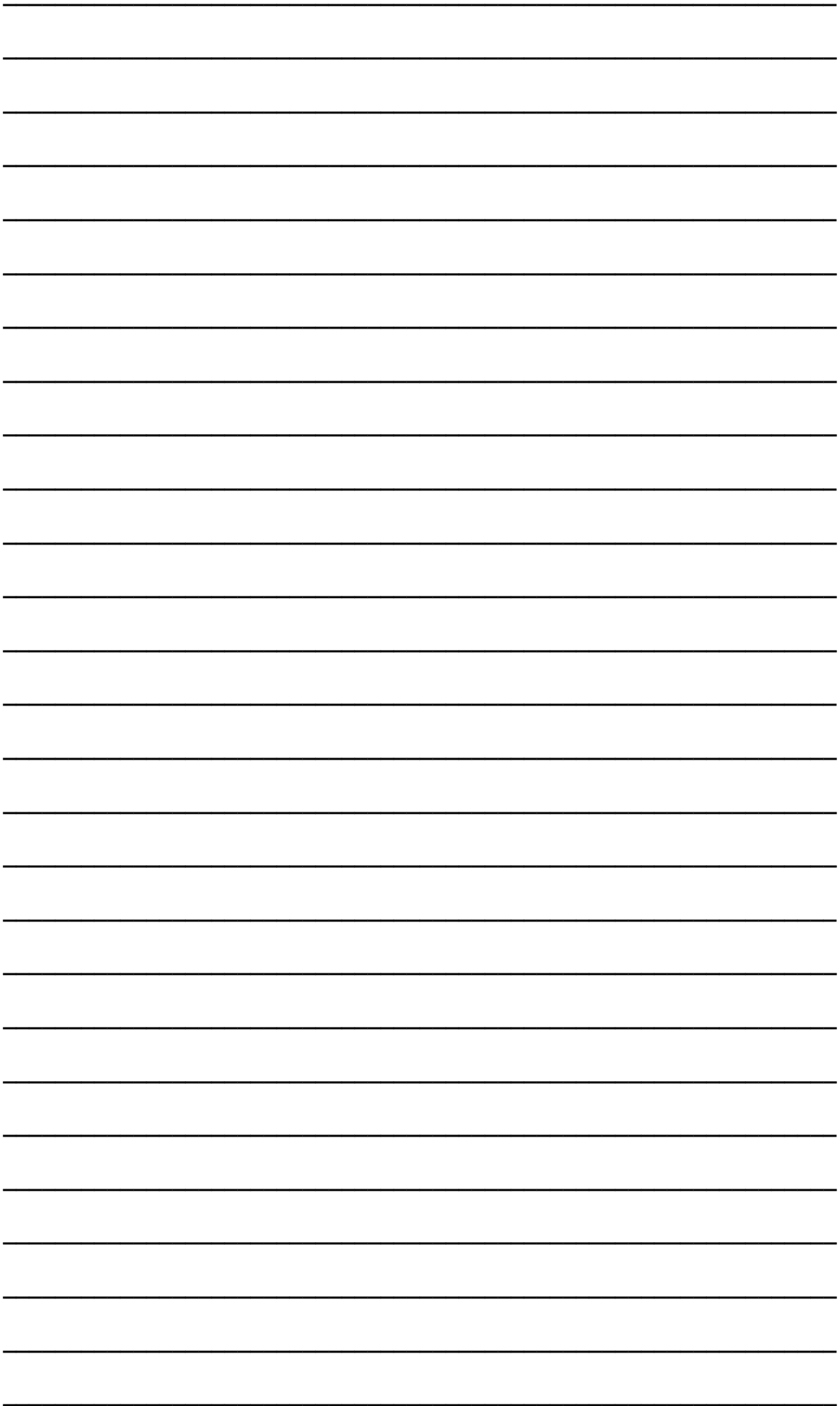

**“That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life—<sup>2</sup>the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us—<sup>3</sup>that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. <sup>4</sup>And these things we write to you that <sup>5</sup>your joy may be full.” 1 John 1-4**

**5 This is the message, which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. 6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. 7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. 8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. 1 John 5-10**

1 John 1:9 is an invitation to those who had not yet believed, to become part of the fellowship.

### **No Sacrifice Left**

**26 For if we sin wilfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, 27 but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. Hebrews 10:26-27**

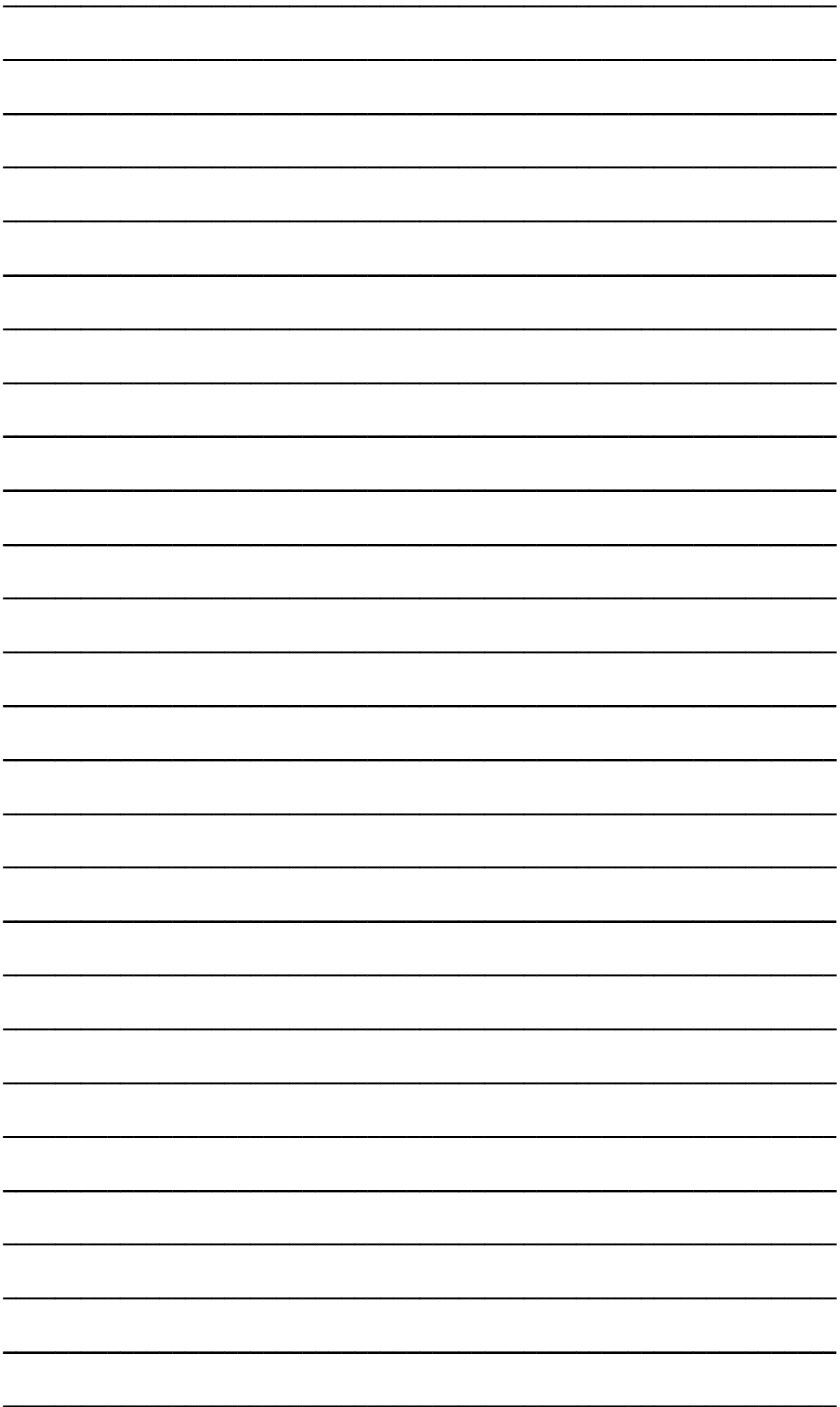

For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. ²For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins. Hebrews 10:1-2

But in those sacrifices, *there is* a reminder of sins every year. ⁴For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins. Hebrews 10:3-4

Now where there is remission of these, *there is* no longer an offering for sin. Hebrews 10:18

For if we sin wilfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins... Hebrews 10:26

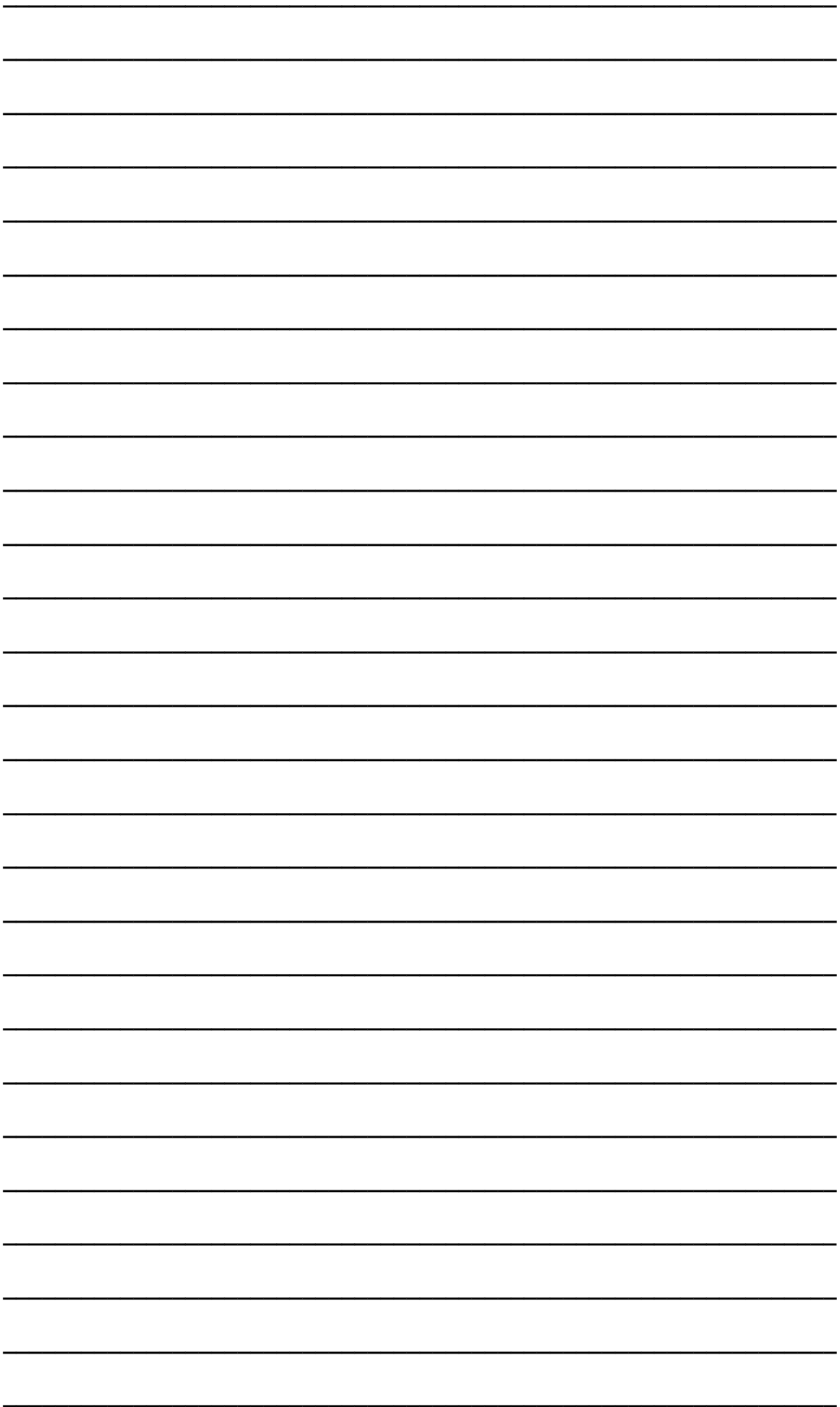

## License to Sin

Moreover, the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more, so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 5:20-21

What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? <sup>2</sup>Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? <sup>3</sup>Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? <sup>4</sup>Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Romans 6:1-4

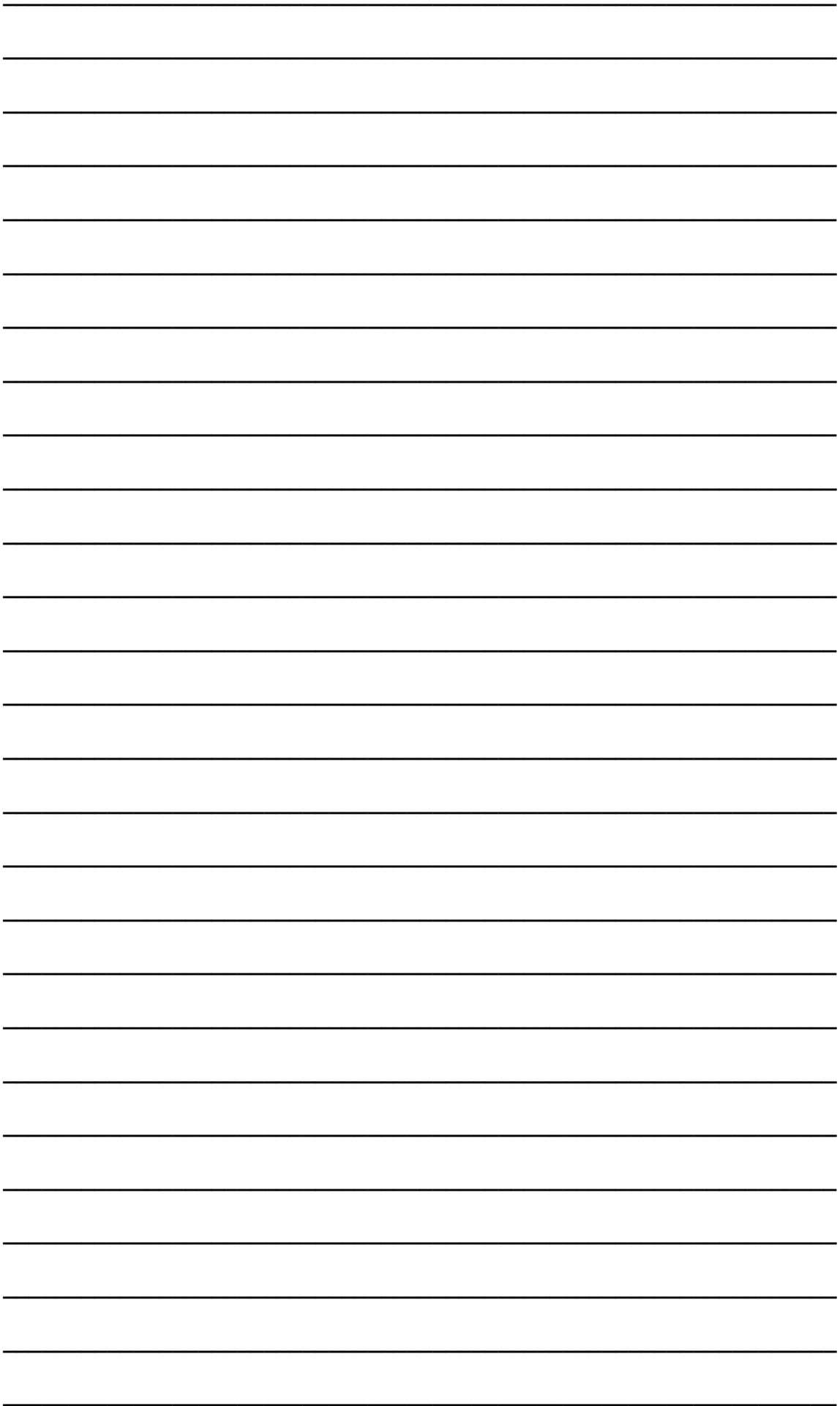
